Harvest InterContinental Ministries Sierra Leone is a Church Planting Movement with over 130 Churches and Fellowships across the country including Public Schools, a Bible Institute, a Christian College and a Radio Station. We are committed to fulfill the Great Commission by Winning The Lost At All Costs, making disciples and training of leaders.

Our Vision And Mission

It is now our desire more than ever before with a vision to see "A World Where No One Lives Or Dies Without Christ". We are still committed to Winning The Lost At All Costs in unreached towns and villages within Sierra Leone. We desire to see the percentage of followers of Christ increasing by a higher percentage in the not too distant future. As we continue to partner with the Holy Spirit, we believe that all things are possible.

SAVE Partnership

Over 20 years now, Sierra Leone Agape Volunteer Efforts (SAVE) based in USA has been one of our key partners in our church planting efforts in Sierra Leone. They have been very instrumental in helping us to build a School, build churches and provide support to train our Pastors. Two years ago, a team of SAVE board members from USA joined our team of medical doctors and nurses to provide free medical services for about a week in a remote village in Sierra Leone where there was no healthcare facility. In April of 2021, SAVE helped to sponsor our first session of the Harvest School of Missions and Church planting, an intensive training for about 60 participants who came from various parts of the country. At the end of the training, these students were inspired to go into various towns and villages and planted about 19 Churches before the end of 2021. SAVE was also able to sponsor about 200 of our Pastors and Church Leaders from the Provinces to attend the annual convention (LIBERATION) of Harvest Intercontinental Sierra Leone for additional training in

PLANS AND GOALS FOR 2022

Our Plans and Goals are God-Sized. We have a goal of Planting 1000 and More Churches in the coming years if Jesus carries. To archive that long term goal, we have the following short term plans and goals for 2022.

1. Have another Harvest School Session this coming April.
2. Be able to reach a 200 Churches and Fellowship by December 2022.

HARVEST PARTNERS

With the help of some of our Harvest Partners in some of our Harvest Churches, we were able to help our Regional Overseers with funds for Church planting, funds to the National Overseer to verify all our Churches nationwide and purchasing of 21 portable speakers for our Church planters.

Below are pictures of the medical missions held in the Magbety Village Tonkolili District in the North or Sierra Leone. This medical missions was sponsored by SAVE in collaboration with medical Doctors and nurses within Harvest Intercontinental Churches in Sierra Leone. Over 500 patients were attended to and free drugs was administered within a period of five days. Many villagers received Christ and were added to the Harvest Church with surrounding villages requesting a church plant.

WATER SUPPLY AT MAGBETY

Due to the lack of safe and accessible drinking water, one of the board members of SAVE (Chris Follman) together with a close friend of hers, decided to personally raise some funds to provide a well for the village in order to reduce the risk of water-borne diseases. This project was completed and launched in March of 2021 exactly a year after we had the medical missions there.



MVI PARTNERSHIP

Over the last few years, through the SAVE partnership, Harvest Intercontinental Ministries in Sierra Leone was introduced to Missionary Ventures international who have donated over ten motorcycles to our Church Planters. In 2021, we received funds to purchase five brand new motorcycles to empower our Church planters which has immensely contributed to our Church planting drive.
