EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

We are profoundly grateful for the generous financial donation from SAVE'S (Sierra Leone Agape Voluntary Effort) Inc, which has been strategically deployed to sustain and expand the operations of the Evangelical Fellowship of Sierra Leone (EFSL). Your partnership has directly fueled our administrative capacity, grassroots church planting, and mass evangelism efforts. Below is a detailed outline of the tangible impact your investment has made in this reporting period.

1. SUSTAINING CORE OPERATIONS: CHURCH EMPOWERMENT & ADVOCACY DEPARTMENT

The donation provided critical financial stability by covering the monthly salaries of two dedicated staff members within the Church Empowerment and Advocacy Department.

The Impact: By ensuring these staff members are compensated reliably, EFSL has maintained uninterrupted administrative and operational momentum. This has allowed the department to successfully continue its mandate of equipping local churches, providing theological resources, and advocating for the rights and needs of the church community at local and national levels. Your funding essentially protected the "engine room" of our empowerment initiatives.

2. FUELING GRASSROOTS EXPANSION: SUPPORT FOR CHURCH PLANTERS

A vital portion of the SAVE'S financial donation was allocated as monthly stipends to three frontline church planters. Supporting these specific men of God has accelerated our church planting initiatives:

- Pastor Patrick Kanu
- Pastor Amose Kamara
- Pastor Joseph Kamara

The Impact: In many contexts, church planters must balance secular work with ministry, which slows down the growth of new fellowships. The provision of these stipends liberated Pastors Patrick, Amose, and Joseph to dedicate their full time and energy to pioneering new churches, shepherding new converts, and conducting community outreach without the immediate anxiety of providing for their families. This investment is yielding new, self-sustaining congregations.

3. HARVESTING SOULS: THE JESUS FILM MINISTRY

SAVE'S Financial also sponsored our Jesus Film ministry campaigns, utilizing one of the most effective visual evangelism tools available.

A Night in the Village: The Ripple Effect of Your Gift : To understand the true impact of your donation, consider a single evening in a remote Sierra Leonean village. As the sun sets, a makeshift screen is hung between two mango trees. Curious villagers gather in the dusk—many hearing the Gospel in their own language for the very first time as the Jesus Film begins to play. When the film ends, it isn't just a movie that lingers; it is an invitation. Because of your funding, Pastors Patrick Kanu, Amose and Joseph are already there in the crowd. They do not just hand out a pamphlet; because their stipend allow them to be fully dedicated to this village, they stay to answer questions, pray with the hurting, and follow up the very next day. The souls saved through this ministry aren't just numbers on a page—they are individuals stepping from the shadows of the screen into the light of a newly planted church.

During this period, the Jesus Film ministry achieved the following remarkable results:

- Total Reached: A total of 639 individuals were reached with the Gospel message through public screenings in various communities.
- Souls Won: Praise be to God, a total of 105 souls made a concrete decision to accept Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior. (**Note:** These new converts are currently being followed up on and integrated into local church fellowships, including the newly planted churches led by the pastors mentioned above).



SAVE'S Financial support has done far more than balance our books; it has paid the salaries of those advocating for the church, sustained the livelihoods of men planting new congregations, and facilitated the eternal transformation of hundreds of souls through the Jesus Film.

EFSL deeply values your trust and partnership. Because of your financial commitment, the Great Commission is being advanced with measurable success.

We look forward to continuing this fruitful partnership and sharing even greater testimonies of impact in the future.
